

Visit the monuments, the local trade, coffee-shops and restaurants. Wander around remote beaches and endless sand dunes - all this just a step away from O Tamanco.

1 Figuera Da Foz

Old-fashioned, colorful resort and fishing port with a wide beach and great surfing south of the Mondego river.

Salinas near Figuera Da

Go on a walking tour through the salpans with Museu do Sal. It is a wonderful place where many different bird species like flamingos can be seen.

3 Canoeing

On the Mondego river between Penacova and Coimbra there are 16km of calm waters running through a variety of natural habitats. perfect for canoeists without much experience.

- Coimbra Stroll through the narrow streets of this old fado-loving university town.
- 5 Mosteiro da Seiça Tour through woods and hills, along rice fields, quaint villages, storks and discover the remnants of a deserted monastery.
- 6 Surfing at Praia Cabedela Secret paradise of surf south of the Mondego river mouth, not many crowds and great waves.
- 7 Osso da Baleia A stunning sandy beach named after the phenomenon of whales being washed ashore. The name means "bones of the whale."
- O Tamanco Camping & Cantina
- Louriçal Visit the weekly market with its delicious chicken piri-piri.
- 10 River Pools A string of river beaches with clear, cool water sourrounded by trees and cliffs.

- Serra de Sicó Rock climbing in three different zones at Redinha, 30 minutes from O Tamanco.
- Praia de Pedrogão Locally caught fresh fish from the grill.
- Lagoa da Evedeira Freshwater lake in the midst of dunes, ideal for small children. Snackbar on site.
- Supermarkets Gasstation, laundrymat, cash machine and Intermarché (big supermarket), as well as Bricomarché (hardwares).
- 15 Fonte da Pedra Picnic area surrounded by trees. In the summer, families gather for lunch and eat bread and suckling pig.
- Pombal Sleepy provincial town where time stands still. Last week of September: Feira de Artesanatos, beginning of November: Festa de castanhas e ague pé
- São Pedro de Moel Old "chic" seaside resort situated in a bay. Many old villas.
- Leiria Cool and trendy shops in the narrow streets of the old town surrounding the castle
- A small chapel was built at the site of Marian appari-

tions, witnesed by three local shepherd children, now known as Our Lady of Fátima. Betweeen 6 and 8 million pilgrims visit yearly.
